

## CHP at a Glance

### Overview:

Catholic Health Partners (CHP) is the largest health system in Ohio and the fourth largest employer in Ohio, and CHP is also one of the largest nonprofit health systems in the United States. We operate more than 100 healthcare organizations that meet the healthcare needs of people in Ohio and Kentucky.

### Mission & Values:

CHP's mission is to extend the healing ministry of Jesus by improving the health of our communities with emphasis on people who are poor and under-served. In all that we do, we strive to demonstrate our core values of compassion, excellence, human dignity, justice, sacredness of life and service.

### Regional Health Systems:

CHP consists of seven regional health systems that provide a wide range of healthcare services. All of our regional health systems include acute care hospitals, and many of them also include long-term care residences, housing sites for the elderly, home health agencies, hospice programs, outreach services and wellness centers.

Our regional health systems are organized within two divisions:

- The **North Division** includes Mercy in Toledo, Ohio; Mercy in Lorain, Ohio; and St. Rita's Health Partners in Lima, Ohio. Humility of Mary Health Partners in Youngstown, Ohio, operates as a stand-alone region.
- The **Central/Senior Health & Housing Services Division** includes Community Mercy Health Partners in Springfield, Ohio, Mercy Health Partners – Kentucky in Paducah, Ky., and Mercy Health Partners - Southwest Ohio in Cincinnati, Ohio, as well as the Senior Health and Housing Services Division.
